




#### Production Tax - Specifics Matter

- 2003 Exploration Credits Introduced
- 2006 (PPT) Switch from Gross to Net
  - Credits expanded to cover investment and losses
  - Progressivity introduced
- 2007 (ACES) Progressivity rate augmented to .4%/\$ above \$30 a barrel net (i.e. every \$10/bbl increase in net value raises total tax rate by 2.5%)
- 2010 (CIRA) Credits expanded to cover well work (IDCs & Well Workovers) for Cook Inlet (not North Slope)
- 2011 HB 110 introduced by Governor, Passed House
  - Credits Expanded to North Slope wells
  - Base rate and progressivity cut back with new "new field" tier that is 10% lower than exisitng fields


